



Jan. 29, 2010 (COW 1337 – Shell Station Assault)

A convenience store clerk stopped a shoplifting incident, but was assaulted as a result. The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your tips to help solve the case.

Three men entered the Shell station at 13101 Hull Street Road at approximately 2:30 p.m. on Monday, Nov. 30, 2009. One man stole something and placed it in his pocket. The manager told the suspect to return the item and leave the store.

All three men left the store, but two men returned five minutes later. One suspect swore at the manager and struck him in the face.

The suspects are black males in their early to mid 20s. The assault suspect wore a blue and white shirt with horizontal stripes with a white T-shirt underneath. The second suspect wore a heavy, red and black coat and a white shirt with a print.



Jan. 22, 2010 (COW 1336 – Copper thefts)

The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to catch the suspect or suspects who broke into a vacant store and stole thousands of dollars worth of copper pipes and wire.

The suspect or suspects broke into Kroger at 12201 South Chalkley Road and stole 3,000 feet of cooper HVAC pipe, 2,400 feet of cooper water pipe and a large amount of copper wire sometime between Dec. 19 and Dec. 28, 2009.





Jan. 15, 2010 (COW 1335 – “Cindy” Robbery)

The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program is asking for your help to solve an unusual robbery case.

In May 2009, a victim was chatting via e-mail with a woman he knew as Cindy. The victim drove from North Carolina to meet Cindy at a home on Folkstone Road in Chesterfield County on June 16. The man was beaten and robbed by seven to eight men when he entered the home. Stolen items included cash and personal items.

The suspects are described as Hispanic males in their mid to late 20s. One suspect displayed a gun and another displayed a knife. The suspects fled in a blue or gray Toyota. Detectives have learned the Folkstone Road home is used to house out-of-town Verizon subcontractors.



Jan. 8, 2010 (COW 1334 – Robbery on Marina Dr.)

Crime Solvers needs your help to catch four men who robbed victims at gunpoint in the 2500 block of Marina Drive on Sunday, Nov. 29.

The two victims were in the parking lot at 11:05 p.m. when three men approached, displayed guns and demanded money. A fourth suspect sat in a waiting van. The suspects assaulted one victim after they stole a wallet and cell phone. The victim's stolen credit card was used to make fraudulent purchases at Wal-Mart, 7901 Brook Road and Wawa, 5231 Brook Road.



All four suspects are between 23-28 years old. The first suspect is a heavy-set white male who wore a white T-shirt, yellow or tan jacket and dark pants. The second suspect is a black male who wore a white T-shirt, dark pants and tan boots. The third suspect is a heavy-set black male who wore black clothing. The fourth suspect is a black male who wore a yellow shirt, dark pants and sandals. The suspect vehicle is a dark green mini van.
