

February 27, 2009 (COW – El Paisano Robbery)



The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to solve a robbery that occurred at El Paisano Market at 2500 Willis Road on Feb. 2.

Two masked men entered the store at about 9:20 p.m. and robbed the employees at knifepoint. The suspects took money from one employee and then ordered a second employee to open the store's register. The suspects fled east through the parking lot upon receipt of the money.

Both suspects are Hispanic males and may be of Salvadorian or Guatemalan decent. The first suspect is 5 feet 6 inches tall. He wore a black hooded sweatshirt with a blue knit hat with two yellow stripes. The second suspect is 5 feet 8 inches tall. He wore a blue sweater, a black hat and a blue bandana to conceal his face.



February 20, 2009 (COW – Car Stop Store Burglary)



Crime Solvers needs your help to catch two men who broke into the Car Stop convenience store at 7431 Jefferson Davis Highway on Sunday, Jan. 18.

The suspects unsuccessfully tried to force the front doors open with an unknown tool at 4:38 a.m. The suspects left, returned 20 minutes later and used an axe to smash one of the glass doors to gain entry to the store. Nothing was reported

stolen.



The first suspect is a male of an unknown race, late teens or early 20s and 6 feet tall. He wore jeans and a blue or purple hooded sweatshirt. The second suspect is a male of an unknown race in his 20s and wore jeans with patches and a multi-colored hooded sweatshirt. The suspects drove a silver or gray four-door car with five-spoke factory rims.



February 13, 2009 (COW – Stolen Debit Card & Check Fraud)



Crime Solvers needs your help to identify a man and woman who used a victim's stolen debit card to purchase gift cards from a Colonial Heights store and later cashed the victim's checks out of state.

The victim's wallet and checks were stolen from her purse between 5 and 7 p.m. on Friday, Dec. 5 at Cracker Barrel, 12401 Redwater Creek. The suspects used the stolen debit card to purchase gift cards at Target, 721 Southpark Boulevard in

Colonial Heights. The suspects unsuccessfully attempted to make purchases at the Wal-Mart store and BP station, both on Temple Avenue in Colonial Heights. In January, the victim learned that someone in Chicago, IL had withdrawn a large amount of money from her bank account.

Surveillance cameras at Target and Wal-Mart captured images of the two suspects. **The first suspect is a black male and the second is a white female. A dark, full-sized SUV may also be involved.**



February 6, 2009 (COW – Abduction Robbery at East Coast Station)

Crime Solvers needs your help to catch the two men who abducted a man from the East Coast gas station at 12500 Jefferson Davis Highway on Saturday, Nov. 22, 2008.

The victim was pumping gas shortly after midnight when a man approached the victim, displayed a gun and forced the victim into the back seat of his own vehicle. A second suspect then got into the passenger seat. The suspects drove the victim around for several hours and made different stops. Later that afternoon, the suspects drove to Burger King at 3116 Boulevard in Colonial Heights, exited the vehicle and got into a waiting vehicle in the parking lot.



Both suspects are black males. The first suspect is 45-47 years old, 5 feet 8 inches tall, 160 pounds with short, gray and black hair. He wore blue jeans, a navy blue hooded sweatshirt and a black coat. The second suspect is 20-25 years old, 6 feet tall, 160 pounds and had shoulder-length braids. He wore jeans and a puffy, red coat with a hood.
