

JANUARY 30, 2009 (COW – Computer Theft from Walmart)

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to solve a theft from a local Wal-Mart store.



On July 3, 2008, a man entered the Wal-Mart in Midlothian and walked to the electronics section. There he loaded two Dell computers onto a cart. He walked to the exit doors, showed an employee some paperwork, and proceeded to the lot. He loaded the computers into a dark-colored, full-size, king- or extended-cab pickup truck.



The suspect is a white male, 30-39 years old, approximately 5 feet, 8 inches tall and 170 pounds. He was wearing a white T-shirt, khaki shorts and sandals.

JANUARY 23, 2009 (COW – Village Bank Robbery)

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to catch the man who robbed two people as they were making a night deposit at the Village Bank at 13531 Midlothian Turnpike.



On Sunday, Dec. 7, 2008, at 10:20 p.m., two people pulled up to the night-deposit drawer to deposit a bank bag. The suspect appeared beside the driver's side window, pointed a gun at the male victim's head and motioned for the bank bag. After receiving the bag, the suspect ran around the west corner of the bank.

The suspect is described as a black male, between 20 and 30 years old, 6 feet tall with a dark complexion. He was wearing a puffy, black jacket with orange lining and fur inside the hood. His face was covered with a camouflage mask.

JANUARY 16, 2009 (COW – Electric Breaker Theft)



The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to solve a theft in which 68 high-voltage electrical breakers were stolen from the Watkins Center Development construction site on Midlothian Turnpike, near the Route 288 exchange.

Someone stole the breakers between 8 p.m. on Nov. 24 and 6:40 a.m. on Nov. 25. The breakers are used in commercial construction. Detectives believe a dark, Dodge 4x4 pick up truck with a lift kit and mud tires may have been involved.



JANUARY 9, 2009 (COW – Surrywood Pool Vandalism)



Crime Solvers needs your help to catch the person or people who vandalized the Surrywood pool house, playground and a Chesterfield County school bus at 2300 Williamstown Drive.

On the weekend of Nov. 29, someone spray painted obscenities, swastikas and the phrase “Ben was hurr” on the pool house walls and school bus.

JANUARY 2, 2009 (COW – El Tequila Robbery)

Crime Solvers needs your help to catch two men who robbed a man in the parking lot of El Tequila restaurant at 9645 Jefferson Davis Highway on Nov. 15, 2008.

The victim got into his vehicle at about 1:45 a.m. and two men opened the vehicle door and demanded money. The suspects struck the victim in the face when the victim refused to comply and then stole his wallet and cell phone. The suspects fled in an older gray pick up truck.

The victim's stolen credit card was used minutes later to buy gas from the Orange Market at 6701 Courthouse Road. The suspects unsuccessfully attempted to buy items at the Wal-Mart at 12200 Chattanooga Plaza.



The first suspect is a black male, 28-32 years old, 5 feet 11 inches tall and wore dark clothing. The second suspect is a white male, 28-32 years old, 6 feet tall, full beard and wore a white T-shirt and blue jeans.
