

October 30, 2009 (COW – Electronics theft/Walmart)



Crime Solvers needs your help to identify two men who stole electronics from Wal-Mart at 900 Wal-Mart Way over a two-day period.

Two male suspects manipulated locks on display cases in the electronics section between Tuesday, May 26 and Thursday, May 28. Stolen items included DVD players, Canon, Sony and Nikon digital cameras. Employees discovered the thefts after they found empty product boxes scattered throughout the store.



Both suspects are black males between 30 and 40 years old. The first suspect is about 5 feet 10 inches tall, 240 pounds and had a towel on his shoulder. The second suspect is about 5 feet 10 inches tall and 175 pounds. Surveillance photos can be seen on the Web at www.crimesolvers.net.

October 2, 2009 (COW – Diamond Concepts Theft)

While an employee was helping another customer, one suspect used a tool to pry the glass from a display case and the second suspect reached in and stole three rings. They were 4.5, 3.25 and 3.5 carat diamond rings with white gold bands. Surveillance cameras captured images of the suspects who wiped the glass with a sweatshirt before they left the store.
