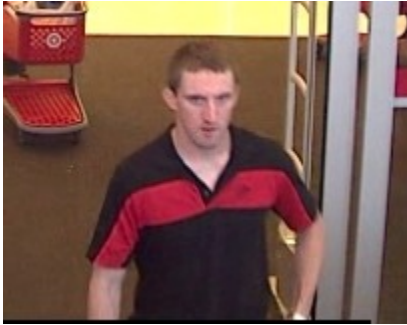


September 25, 2009 (COW – iPods stolen from Target)

Crime Solvers needs your help to identify a man who fraudulently obtained money from an area Target store on Monday, Sept. 7.



An unidentified man purchased and paid cash for three Apple iPods from the 11301 Midlothian Turnpike store. He left the store, replaced the iPods with lug nuts, rewrapped the packages with shrink-wrap and then returned the items for cash.

The suspect is a white male 20-30 years old with short, brown hair. He wore a black short-sleeve shirt with a red stripe across the chest.

September 18, 2009 (COW – 7-Eleven robbery)



Crime Solvers needs your help to solve a robbery that occurred at 7-Eleven, 1931 Huguenot Road on Wednesday, June 24.

A masked man entered the store at about 4:47 a.m., approached a clerk, displayed a gun and demanded money from the register and safe. The suspect then grabbed money from the register. When the suspect learned the safe could not be opened, he cursed at the clerk and fled on foot southbound.

On July 10, the victim contacted police when she realized that her credit cards were missing. When she called to cancel the credit cards, she was told that they had already been used at Wal-Mart and at Target to purchase electronics which included a 40' inch TV.



The suspect is described as a black female with long black hair and sunglasses. She was dressed in all black clothing and may be driving a silver or gray SUV.



September 4, 2009 (COW – Car Break-in at Church & Dwight)



Crime Solvers needs your help this week to identify a man who broke into and stole a victim's purse from her car at the Church & Dwight Factory, 1851 Touchstone Road on Tuesday, Dec. 23, 2008.

At about 7:30 p.m., the driver of a dark Pontiac Sunfire pulled in and parked next to the victim's 2000 Chrysler convertible. The suspect exited his car and walked around the victim's car while he appeared to be talking on a cell phone. The suspect cut the victim's convertible top and stole the victim's purse that contained cash, credit cards and personal items.
