RECOVERED BODY IS KELLY CATALANO

CHESTERFIELD COUNTY, VA – Police have confirmed the woman whose body was recovered from a small island in Swift Creek, near the Interstate 95 bridge yesterday is indeed that of Kelly D. Catalano, 40. Police are awaiting final autopsy results, but there were no obvious signs of trauma.

This week, Crime Solvers is asking for your help to locate a missing person. At approximately 10 a.m. on Jan. 15, Kelly Catalano was seen leaving her place of employment in the 16000 block of Innovation Drive in Chesterfield County. Friends and family have not seen or heard from her since. Catalano is a 40-year-old white female, 5 feet 9 inches tall, about 145 pounds with brown hair and brown eyes. She was last seen wearing work boots, blue jeans and a blue work shirt. You may see a recent photo of Catalano on the Crime Solvers Web site, crimesolvers.net. Friends and family of Catalano have created an additional reward fund, whereby tipsters who provide information leading to the location and safe return of Kelly could earn an additional reward up to \$10,000.



Feb. 19, 2010 (COW 1340 - Hank's Barbecue Break-in)

Crime Solvers needs your help to catch the man who broke into Hank's Barbecue at 4810 Jefferson Davis Highway on Sunday, Jan. 24. Police responded to an alarm call at the restaurant at 1:12 a.m. and discovered someone broke a rear window. Nothing was stolen. Surveillance cameras captured images of the suspect breaking the window and entering the business. The suspect is a bald, black male, 30-40 years old and wore dark clothing.



Feb. 12, 2010 (COW 1339 - Charity Box Thefts)

Donation boxes were stolen from two area Latino markets on Nov. 14, 2009. Two men were given permission to place donation boxes for a family in need at La Miguelena Market, 6701 Jefferson Davis Highway, and Nuevo Amanecer Latino Market, 6515 Jefferson Davis Highway. When the men went to collect the boxes they discovered an unknown and unauthorized man had stolen the boxes from both stores. The suspect is a Hispanic male, 35-45 years old, about 5 feet 2 inches tall and 200 pounds. He had a goatee and wore what appeared to be a blue Adidas jacket with white stripes on the sleeves.

Feb. 5, 2010 (COW 1338 - ATM Debit Card Theft)

Crime Solvers needs your help to identify a man who stole a credit card from an automated teller machine and then used the card to make fraudulent purchases at two area stores on Jan. 8, 2010. The victim mistakenly left her credit card in the ATM at the Bank of America branch at 10700 Midlothian Turnpike. Surveillance cameras later captured images of the suspect using the victim's credit card at the Wawa at 7316 Forest Hill Avenue and Wal-mart at 2501 Shelia Lane. The suspect is a black male with facial hair. He wore a dark jacket and hat and drove a light colored four-door vehicle.
