



### **March 26, 2010 (COW 1345-TV Thefts/Walmart)**

Crime Solvers needs your help to identify two women who stole televisions from Walmart at 900 Walmart Way on Friday, Nov. 13, 2009.

Between 6:30 and 7 p.m., two women loaded two Samsung 32-inch, high-definition televisions onto a cart, showed the greeter a receipt and walked out the store. Management later determined the receipt was fraudulent.



Both suspects are black females and each had their hair pulled into a ponytail. The first suspect is heavysset and wore a dark sweatshirt, light T-shirt, blue jeans and white tennis shoes. The second is thin and wore a dark winter parka, purple or blue T-shirt with print on the front, jeans and white shoes. The Chesterfield / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to catch the man who robbed the Wachovia Bank branch at 2000 Snead Avenue in Colonial Heights on Friday, March 5.

The suspect entered the bank at 10 a.m., approached a teller and presented a note that demanded money. After receiving the cash, the suspect fled on foot and may have gotten into a dark green or gray mini-van with primer paint on the passenger side.



The suspect is a short, white male, 25-30, 5 feet 2 inches to 5 feet 3 inches tall, 140 pounds, short hair and a pronounced chin. He wore an orange University of Virginia baseball hat, dark sunglasses, black zippered jacket and blue jeans.

The second suspect loaded the two computers into a shopping cart, walked around the store for several minutes and then exited without paying for the items. Both suspects are black males. The first suspect is 6 feet tall, 230 pounds and wore a blue hooded sweatshirt, black hat and glasses. The second suspect is 6 feet 3 inches tall, 260 pounds and wore a white zippered sweatshirt. Both suspects got into a black Chevrolet Trail Blazer.
