



May 28, 2010 (COW 1354 – Robbery / Elsa’s Jewelry)

The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to solve a robbery that occurred at Elsa’s Jewelry at 4010 Meadowdale Boulevard on Thursday, May 13.

Five suspects entered the store separately at 10:29 a.m. and appeared to be shopping. Two of the suspects struck the clerk with a gun, forced her to an office and restrained her. The suspects fled on foot after they stole cash, jewelry, phone cards, cashier’s checks and perfume.

Surveillance cameras captured images of the five suspects who are Hispanic males in their mid 20s to mid 30s.

May 21, 2010 (COW 1353 – Stolen Credit Card / Cracker Barrel)



The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to solve a case in which a victim's stolen credit card was used to make fraudulent purchases at two area stores after her purse was stolen from Cracker Barrel at 12401 Redwater Creek Road on Feb. 9.



The victim dined at the restaurant between 6:30 and 7:15 p.m. and discovered her purse had been stolen. The victim then learned someone used her stolen credit card to make large purchases at the former Ukrop's at 12601 Jefferson Davis Highway and Uppy's at 2421 West Hundred Road.

Uppy's surveillance video captured images of a woman who used the stolen card. The suspect is a white female, 40s to 50s, 5 feet 2 inches tall and long, brown hair. She drove a white four-door pick up truck.

May 14, 2010 (COW 1352 – Digital Camera Theft / CVS)



The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to catch a man who stole two digital cameras from CVS at 10100 Robious Road on Monday, April 12.

The suspect entered the store at 6:30 p.m., took a pair of scissors from the office supply aisle, and then stole the cameras after he cut the anti-theft cords.

The suspect is a white male 33-37 years old, 6 feet tall and 220 pounds. He wore a blue button-down shirt, blue jean shorts and white tennis shoes.
