



June 25, 2010 (COW 1358 - Perlock 7-Eleven Robbery)

The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify and catch a young male who robbed the 7-Eleven located at 9700 Jefferson Davis Highway on Sunday, April 18.

At approximately 3:30 a.m., a young black male walked into the store while covering his face with his sweatshirt sleeve. He immediately approached the clerk, pointed a dark semi-automatic handgun and demanded money from the register. After taking the money, the suspect left on foot toward Perlock Road.

The suspect is a black male with a dark complexion, between 18-25 years old, 6 feet tall with an average build. He was wearing an oversized gray sweatshirt with black pull strings, a black baseball cap and baggy, black Rocawear jeans.



June 18, 2010 (COW 1357 - Fast & Friendly Robbery)

June 11, 2010 (COW 1356 - MDA Collection Container Thefts)



Someone stole Muscular Dystrophy Association collection boxes from two area 7-Eleven stores, and the Chesterfield/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program wants to help law enforcement identify the suspect.

On April 24, just after 9 p.m., a woman stole a collection container from the 7-Eleven located at 4700 Walmsley Blvd. in Richmond. Then, on Saturday, May 1, at about 10 a.m., the same female suspect stole a donation container from the 7-Eleven located at 5549 Belmont Road in Chesterfield County.

The suspect is a tall black female with a dark complexion and short black hair. She appears to be in her 30s. During the Richmond incident, she wore a red T-shirt, dark pants and white tennis shoes. A female child, approximately 3 years old, was with her. During the Chesterfield incident, she wore a red, sleeveless shirt with shorts.



June 4, 2010 (COW 1355 - Robbery at Casa Blanca)
