



July 30, 2010 (COW 1363 - TJ Maxx Credit Card Thefts)

The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to solve two separate thefts in which credit cards were stolen from victims while they shopped at T.J. Maxx stores at 1321 Carmia Way and 4851 Commonwealth Centre Parkway on Sunday, July 11. The suspects distracted the victims, stole their wallets from their purses and then used stolen credit cards to make fraudulent purchases in Richmond. The suspects are four men and one woman and may be Caucasian or Hispanic. The suspects may be driving a gray Dodge minivan with Florida plates.

July 23, 2010 (COW 1362 - CSX Vandalism)



The Chesterfield County/Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs help with an unusual case involving a train. Between 6 p.m. Friday, May 21, and 5:30 p.m. Saturday, May 22, someone pulled logs and other debris onto the railroad tracks that run between Mistwood Forest Subdivision and Richmond Steel, 14500 Jefferson Davis Highway. An Amtrak train running on the rails hit the debris, causing the brakes to lock and the train to be stuck until repairs could be made. Trains that are stopped on the tracks unexpectedly cause a



huge expense to both the train and rail companies. During the investigation it was learned that some maintenance equipment and vehicles belonging to CSX were vandalized while on the property of Richmond Steel. Windows were broken and items were spray painted with blue and orange paint.



July 16, 2010 (COW 1361 - Mincz Wheel Theft)

The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to solve two separate thefts in which a large number of vehicle rims were stolen from Mincz Tire Service at 10921 Trade Road. The first theft occurred between the evening hours of June 29 and the morning of June 30. During this theft, more than 80 steel vehicle rims were stolen from the lot. The second theft occurred between the evening hours of July 1 and the morning of July 2. During this theft, about 30 steel vehicle rims were stolen.



July 9, 2010 (COW 1360 - Credit Card Fraud, Suspect with cane)

The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs help to solve a case in which a victim's stolen credit cards were used to make fraudulent purchases. The victim's wallet was stolen from her purse while she shopped at Food Lion, 11102 Hull Street Road at about 11:30 a.m. on Wednesday, June 7. The victim later discovered her stolen credit cards had been used to make more than \$370 in purchases at the following Virginia stores: CVS Pharmacy, 912 East Atlantic





Street, South Hill; Kangaroo Express gas station, 891 Temple Avenue, Colonial Heights; Hancock Service Station, 5610 Hopkins Road, Chesterfield; Walgreens at 20 Buford Road, Chesterfield Walgreens' surveillance video captured images of a woman who used the victim's stolen card to make purchases. The suspect is a black female, about 5 feet 3 inches tall, 220 pounds and medium-length black hair pulled into a ponytail. She wore a white, short-sleeve T-shirt with the letters "SP" on the front. She walked with a cane and a pronounced limp.



July 2, 2010 (COW 1359 - Your Store Robbery)

The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify and catch two men who robbed Your Store at 740 Adkins Road on Thursday, May 20 at about 8:30 p.m. Two men entered at about 8:30 p.m. and approached an employee at the register.
