



### **September 24, 2010 (COW 1371 – Willis Road Shell Station Robbery)**

The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify and find two men who robbed the Shell gas station at 2320 Willis Road on Tuesday, July 20 at about 10:30 p.m.

The suspects approached an employee, demanded money and cigarettes at gunpoint and then fled on foot toward the VIP Inn. The witness described the suspects as black males with thin builds, 150 lbs., and wearing dark clothing with black masks.



### **September 17, 2010 (COW 1370 – Kroger Gas Kiosk Robbery)**

The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs help to identify two men who robbed the Kroger gasoline kiosk, 2801 Hicks Road on Wednesday, Aug. 18.

Between 9:45 and 10 p.m. two suspects entered the kiosk office while the clerk was busy with a vendor outside. When the clerk returned, the suspects restrained her, displayed a gun and stole money from the register. The suspects fled toward an abandoned house at the corner of Hicks Road and Route 360 where detectives believe a car was waiting for them.



The suspect who held the clerk at gunpoint is a black male, 42-49 years old. He had a mustache, appeared unshaven and wore a blue baseball hat with the Denver Nugget's basketball logo. The second suspect was a thinner black male, 32-39 years old. He had a mustache, goatee, and wore a dark Gold's Gym sweatshirt with yellow lettering on the front and a dark baseball hat with a small red logo.



### **September 10, 2010 (COW 1369 – Fraudulent SunTrust Checks)**

The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs your help to identify a woman who used two fraudulent SunTrust Bank checks to make purchases at Walgreens at 626 Boulevard on Wednesday, Aug. 18.

The suspect is a heavy set black female between 30 and 40 years old and has been using the name Selita Harper.



### **September 3, 2010 (COW 1368 – BP Station Robbery)**

The Chesterfield County / Colonial Heights Crime Solvers program needs help to identify a man who robbed the BP Gas Station, 4224 Beulah Road on June 4.

The masked suspect entered the store at about 9:25 p.m., walked past customers, went behind the counter and pointed a gun at the clerk. He pushed the clerk from the register, stole money and fled the area in a dark sedan that was waiting at the corner of Beulah Road and Fuqua Avenue.



The suspect is a black male, 20-24, 6 feet tall, average build and dark complexion. He pulled his T-shirt over his lower face to conceal his identity. He wore two white T-shirts, long, loose denim shorts, black shoes with white laces and a white baseball hat.
